Objectives


I. Municipalities and Tayar Nepal's Implementing Grantees (IGs) are capacitated to run cash transfer program effectively for the most vulnerable communities impacted by COVID-19.

2. Community resilience strengthened through renovating/constructing community assets.

3. Through revived livelihood options, people are better prepared to cope with the impact of COVID-19

Key activities

- Market assessment in 12 municipalities.
- Develop beneficiary selection criteria for Cash Transfer Program.
- Build capacity of Tayar Nepal's IGs on Cash Transfer Program Intervention.
- Technical support to Tayar Nepal's IGs on beneficiary selection, registration and verification.
- Support Tayar Nepal's IGs for finalization of schemes on Cash for Work intervention.
- Provide technical support for implementation of schemes for Cash for Work intervention.
- Support Financial Service Providers for cash distribution.
- Conduct Post Distribution Monitoring (PDM) in all the 12 municipalities.
- Collection of case stories and final report preparation.
