



SOMALIA CRISIS RECOVERY PROJECT

A flood and disaster recovery, and reconstruction project financed by the World Bank via Somalia's Federal Ministry of Finance (MOF). Aligned with the existing national policies, it builds on responding to the large number of recovery and resilience needs identified during FINA/DINA assessments and National Recovery and Resilience Framework RRF.

Objective: To support the recovery of livelihoods & infrastructure in flood and drought affected areas and strengthen capacity for disaster preparedness nationwide.

Problem Statement: Need to provide comprehensive early recovery support in specific regions impacted by multiple crises like drought, flooding, and conflicts. The regions were Balcad, Beletweyne, Jalalaqsi, Jowhar, & Buloburte districts of Hirshabelle state; and Qandsadhere & Wajid districts of Southwest state.

The WV consortium: World Vision UK, in conjunction with the Somali Resilience Program (SomReP) consortium were contracted to deliver recovery services under Component 1 (immediate basic services & livelihood support for early recovery), and Component 6 (Anticipatory and Recovery Support for Addressing Food Insecurity) of the SCRP. The SomReP consortium includes: WVI Somalia, Action Against Hunger (ACF), Danish Refugee Council (DRC).

Interventions: The interventions included Cash for Work; Basic Health & Nutrition Services; Household Hygiene Promotion & Treatment; and Restoring & Protecting Agricultural Crop Production.

The interventions supported the recovery of the beneficiaries & their communities, thus having a multiplier effect of improving the lives of children



Somalia Crisis Recovery Project (SCRP) Components 1 & 6a+


Project Implementation: - The Ministry of Finance - through its Project Implementation Unit - contracted World Vision UK (WVUK) & the SomReP consortium (Action Against Hunger (ACF); Danish Refugee Council (DRC); World Vision International Somalia (WVIS); & Shaqodoon) to deliver: *Component 1* (Immediate basic services and livelihood support for early recovery); and *Component 6a+* (Anticipatory and Recovery Support for Addressing Food Insecurity) of the SCRP.

Project Governance: - The Project is overseen by a Project Steering Committee (PSC), a multi-partner working committee convened with the purpose of guiding and overseeing the Somalia Crisis Recovery Project (SCRP). The PSC is composed of the Office of the Prime Minister (OPM), Ministry of Finance (MOF), Ministry of Planning, Investment, and Economic Development (MoPIED) as permanent members with adhoc membership by relevant FMS MoPIED.

Project Management: - The project is managed by a Project Implementation Unit (PIU) domiciled at the Ministry of Finance. At state level, the project is managed by State Project Teams (SPTs) housed within the state's Ministry of Planning.
